


INSTRUCTIONS FOR A DOUBLE WRAP CLAMP




Step 1: Cut the wire to length (4 times around the item you are clamping plus 12 inches of wire.) Fold wire in half, tape (or wire nut) ends together and wrap around item where you want the clamp. Tuck the ends through the loop



Step 3: Place notch at end of tool against the wire loop and turn wingnut clockwise to tighten.




Step 2: Wrap around (inside the first wrap), tuck through the loop again and remove the tape (or wire nut). Place tool as shown, with the wire over the front pin. Twist ends together tightly.



Step 4: Rotate tool over to lock the clamp. Loosen wingnut and remove the ClampTite tool. Clip off wire ends about 1/4" from clamp and push them down against the hose.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR A SINGLE WRAP CLAMP

These three illustrations demonstrate a simplified single strand wrap for a fast and easy fix! This method will allow for as many wraps as desired. Rotate tool 180 degrees to lock clamp. Loosen wingnut and remove the ClampTite tool. Clip wire about 1/4" from the clamp.
